



Seminar “Gross Path Challenge” - Organization

When? Held every Friday, 9:30 am (CET); face-to-face and by a suitable on line platform. This activity is linked to UNIZAR's academic year and does not take place during vacation periods or on holidays that affect Zaragoza. Occasionally, due to *force majeure* circumstances, it has to be cancelled.

Audience? Humans interested in macroscopic veterinary anatomic pathology: Residents in veterinary pathology, ECVF or ACVP diplomates, lecturers, researchers in public centers or private companies, etc. The group at UNIZAR is varied: in the face-to-face group there are always 4th and 5th year students and PhD students from other veterinary disciplines.

Attendance? Free attendance. Only for people in the group of the Doctoral Program in Animal Medicine and Health of UNIZAR: at the end of the seminar a note of attendance is taken, which you can present at your annual evaluation.

Format? 7 macroscopic images of a selected variety of species, tissues, lesions and etiologies are presented. ECVF exam style questions are asked and they answered by the audience. All interventions are oral, either face-to-face or online; remember: *nobody will read the chat*. At the end of each image, an answer proposed by the organizer is discussed.

Language? The seminar is conducted in English.

Call? During the afternoon-evening of every Thursday an email is sent either to confirm or to cancel the seminar. Specific instructions for those on line will also be sent.

System? Face-to-face at the Histology and Anatomic Pathology Teaching Unit of the University of Zaragoza. On line: for the time being, a link is distributed at 9:20am (CET) on Friday but this system can change depending on the speaker. In any case, the specific instructions will be always announced at the Thursday's email.

Duration? Approximately 40 minutes.
